



# St. Columba's College Prep School Extended Day Activities Information

## Upper Prep

- All signing up for clubs is done through the Gateway app.
- Clubs run by St. Columba's staff are free and you just need to book a place.
- Clubs run by external companies will have a charge and you must make sure you have booked a place and completed payment. These are two separate actions and one without the other will not secure a place.
- If you book a place but do not pay for it then you have not secured a place.
- If you pay for a club but haven't booked a place, you will not be given a place on the club.
- If you miss out on a place for a club you may email Mr Turpin, who will add your name to a waiting list. If places become available, parents will be contacted by the office to offer your child a place.
- There is an expectation that all clubs should be committed to for a full term (or half term where specifically mentioned). This is because of the costing of outside tutors/coaches and the viability of clubs in some cases. Pupils leaving clubs mid-term may be liable to the full or partial cost of the term.
- If you are paying for a club using childcare vouchers, you will need to request these from your childcare provider as soon as possible so they are available for the sign up period. You must email Mrs Newland [accountspayable@stcolumbascollege.org](mailto:accountspayable@stcolumbascollege.org) informing her of how much is being transferred and to which clubs you would like the money allocated to. Once she has allocated the money you will then need to make the bookings yourself.
- If your childcare vouchers do not clear in time for the booking window and you choose to pay via bacs transfer, we are unable to refund you the bacs transfer once the booking has been made and replace with the childcare vouchers.
- A pupils' place in a club is dependent on appropriate behaviour during all aspects of school life. Any pupil who is removed because of behaviour from a club may be liable for the cost of the full term.
- If a session is missed, including absence / covid isolation, then parents will only receive a refund if the external organiser agrees. The school is not responsible for refunds for sessions that have been missed.
- Basketball on a Tuesday and Wednesday morning is open to all pupils in the Upper Prep and is just a free session to play with friends. Pupils need trainers and can come in to the hall when the door to the playground is opened.
