School blazer		
Dark grey, full length, straight leg school trousers/pleated knee-length School skirt		
Jumpers must be V-necked and plain black	Jumpers which cover the tie, including hoodies are not acceptable.	
White long or short-sleeved shirt (revere collar for girls)		
House tie for boys and House badge for girls		
Coats, scarves and hats must be plain black or navy.		
Shoes must be black, polishable, sturdy and low-heeled.	Grey ankle socks to be worn. No white socks, canvas shoes, trainers or boots. Tights to be opaque and plain black or dark grey.	
One stud earring in each earlobe is permitted (girls only)	Rings, medals, chains, bracelets, badges, earrings, spacers, tattoos and smart watches are not permitted. No make-up, facial piercings, false nails or nail varnish to be worn.	It is advised not to wear expensive wrist watches to college.
Hair should be neat, tidy and clean. Students should be clean-shaven.	Extreme hairstyles, for example, very short hair, undercuts or layered hair, even if temporarily fashionable, are not permitted, nor obviously coloured or excessively styled hair. Lines and patterns are not to be cut into the hair. Short hair is to be no less than a 3 cut. Hair longer than shoulder -length to be tied back. Any hair accessories should be simple and discreet.	The College is sensitive to the dictates of religious culture and will consider written requests regarding exemptions.
