



## St. Columba's College Prep School Extended Day Activities Information Upper Prep

## Thursday 18th April to Friday 5th July 2024

From next term onwards we will be using SOCS (the same website we use to sports teamsheets and fixture information) for clubs. SOCS allows us to use a preferences sign up instead of a first come first serve. Parents will need to log in to SOCS (using the instructions attached separately) and will have five days to set their preferences for the various clubs throughout the week. SOCS does not currently have a payment portal, although they are in the process of developing one. This means that payment for clubs will still be done through Gateway. The timetable for the sign up process will be as follows:

- Preference setting window Opens 9.00am on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> and closes 23.59pm on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> April.
- Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April Payment requests will be generated on Gateway and parents contacted for those that have been allocated a club with a charge.
- Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> to Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April Payment window on Gateway, if payment is not made during this window then your place will be allocated to another pupil (if you are paying by childcare vouchers this window can be extended but you must contact Mr Turpin so that he is aware that you do want the place).
- Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April Allocated clubs published on your child's SOCS profile, ready for optional calendar sync.
- Clubs run by St. Columba's staff are free and clubs run by external companies will have a charge.
- Please do not pay for a club until you have been emailed to say you have been allocated a place.
- There is an expectation that all clubs should be committed to for a full term (or half term where specifically mentioned). This is because of the costing of outside tutors/coaches and the viability of clubs in some cases. Pupils leaving clubs mid-term may be liable to the full or partial cost of the term.
- A pupils' place in a club is dependent on appropriate behaviour during all aspects of school life.
   Any pupil who is removed because of behaviour from a club may be liable for the cost of the full term.
- If a session is missed because of illness, including absence / covid isolation, sports fixtures or school trip then parents will not receive a refund. The school is not responsible for refunds for sessions that have been missed. If sessions are cancelled, refunds will be processed at the end of the term.
